1 John Strange 3rd great grandfather of Bob Sterrett

Often there are questions about dates and places when assembling a first family's application. There is some of that here. In this case, there are questions about the people involved.

I was relatively certain that Sarah Strange was my 2nd great grandmother from pre-internet oral history. Who her parents were was another matter. Family history also mentions a Mary Elizabeth Brugh (Brough) associated with John Harvey Ollis. Current internet trees have both women with the same birth date and place! For a long time I thought these women were somehow the same person. Then I began to suspect they were a pair of wives of John Harvey. However, John and Sarah married young and apparently were still married on his death. The mystery of the Brughs persists.

I didn't worry about this for a long time – neither interpretation qualifies this ancestor as a first family. John was born in Kentucky in 1807 and moved to Washington County Indiana before 1829. John Strange and Mary Ann Goldsberry were married in Washington County in 1829. Sarah was born in Washington County. All other ancestors were born too late to make the 1840 cutoff for first family's. Enter Solomon Strange, Sarah's older brother, born in Harrison County in 1832! This led me to the 1830 census where the Strange/Goldsberry family were in Blue River Township, Harrison County.

It would seem that living arrangements led John to move back and forth between Harrison and Washington Counties. The presence in 1830 certainly qualifies him as a First Family ancestor.

There is another John Strange among the on-line trees (died 1865) that seems to have been confused with this one. It is going to be difficult to unring this bell.

I couldn't find any land grants for John in any county. This history is devoid of birth and death certificates.

The other two children couldn't be John and Mary's. Siblings of one or the other? John's father died with minor children.

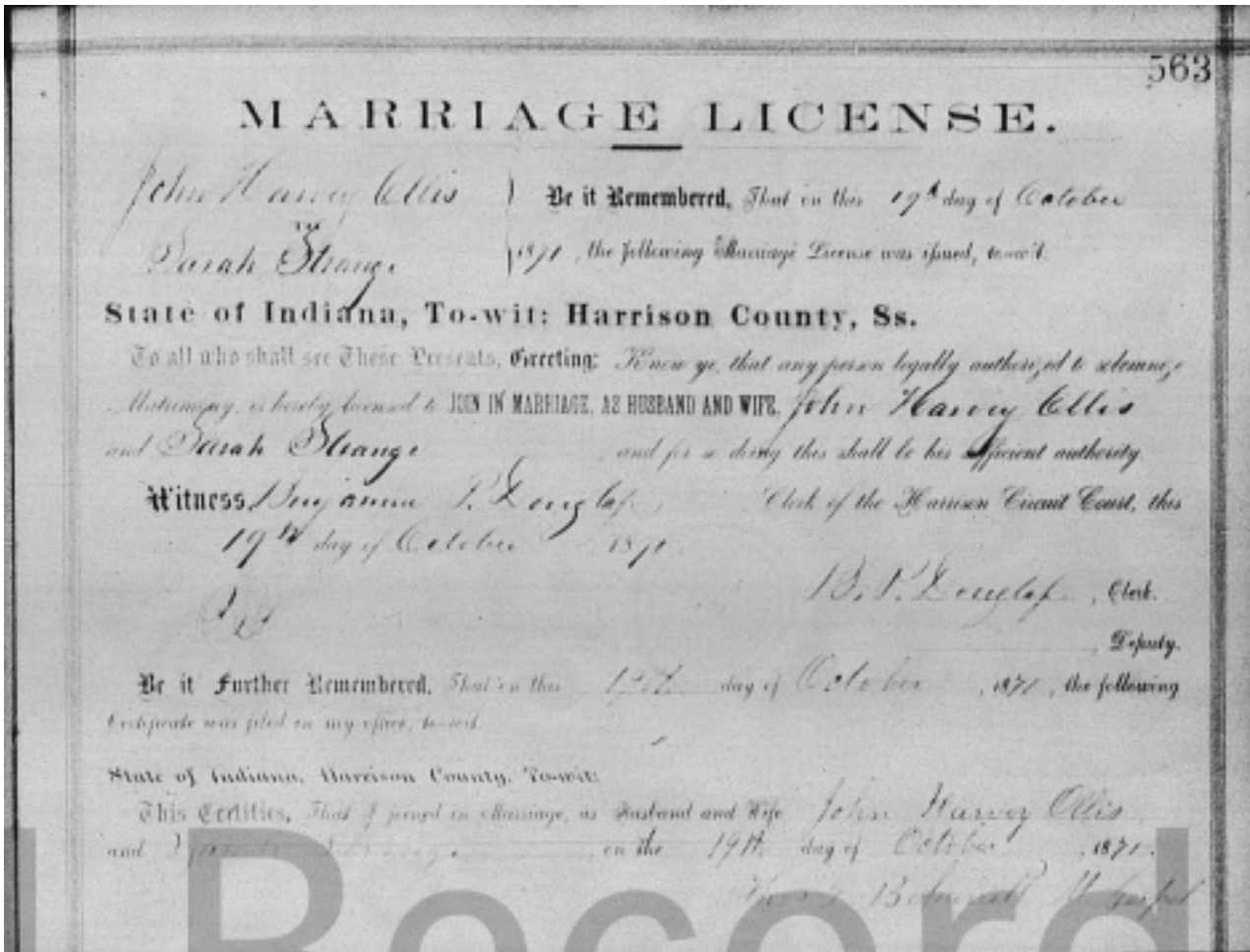

Notice that the birth and death dates are the same as for John Harvey Ollis and the birth date for Mary Elizabeth Brugh is the same as for Sarah Strange!

John could have been briefly married before 1871 when he was 23. No record of this.

The 1900 census shows Elizabeth M in the household of John H Ollis. Unfortunately, divorce records could not be found.

The 1910 census shows John and Elizabeth living in Greenville.

The union would be after the birth of Daniel, the son of William and Sarah Strange.

Did Sarah die before John hooked up with Mary Elizabeth? Can't find Sarah in 1900 census. Are the birth and death dates a conflation of those for Sarah and Mary Elizabeth? I'd like to know, but it doesn't matter for this assertion.

Daniel is the son of Sarah Strange. Sarah Strange is the daughter of John Strange.

Finding a death certificate for Sarah or a marriage license for Mary Elizabeth would be good.

I have the birth date for Mary Elizzabeth Brough as July 1854 and death as 07 Nov 1892 which is contrary to the above.
